新西兰

E-Cig

New Zealand Ministry of Health has signaled they will consider legalizing vaping.

Nicotine e-juice

1. Consumers of vaping products should not notice any difference as nicotine vaping liquid has been available for purchase in retail shops for some time.
2. Heated tobacco products might also become available for sale in New Zealand.

CBD Products

1. New Zealand government has passed the Misuse of Drugs Amendment Regulations 2017 allow some products containing cannabidiol (CBD) to be prescribed without first requiring Ministerial approval
2. Exempted CBD products from the controlled drug records and stock keeping requirements
3. Exempted pharmacies, medical practitioners, and wholesalers from the requirement to have an import licence for CBD products

澳大利亚

E-Cig

Australian public health continues to advocate for bans on E-cig products.

Nicotine e-juice

1. Any nicotine e-juice product is illegal in Australia. Customer can only purchase such product from oversea and less than 120ml.
2. In Australia, nicotine is listed under poison standard, the importer should possess a prescription from a registered medical practitioner.

CBD Products

1. In Australian, CBD items must be prescribed and supplied by a Pharmacy. Prescribing Doctors need registration under the Safe Access Scheme.
2. Products need registration with the TGA for use in a Therapeutic use.
3. Only 23 doctors in Australia that could write a prescription for Epidiolex, a legal cannabidiol product, which was only successful in about 30 per cent of cases.
